All plants are running smoothly; the utility department had no leaks to repair in January. There was a significant leak on E.  $6^{th}$  Street outside the city limits. This line is brittle and not buried very deep. The city council will need to think about replacing the line and moving the meters to the right-of-way in the future.

We are still waiting for the sewer plant pump to ship; there has been a two-month delay. The new blade is installed; the metal fabrication was wrong, but Roy has made the needed correction and will have the blade working soon.

Police Department – Harold Rapsilver, Chief: Chief Harold Rapsilver thanked the council

for their support. Chief Rapsilver notified the council that the traffic was heavier for the month.
